<b>Sep 28</b>	You will need to spend the night in Kilimanjaro or Nairobi this evening. Accommodation can be arranged for you as you prefer.
<b>Sep 29</b>	Morning flight from Kilimanjaro or Nairobi to Cape Town via Nairobi arriving in the evening. Upon arrival, you are met and assisted with your transfer to the Cape Heritage Hotel located in the historic district. Accommodation in one luxury room.
<b>Sep 30</b>	Cape Point and Peninsula Private Full Day Tour. Cape Heritage Hotel.
<b>Oct 01</b>	Winelands Private Full Day Tour. Cape Heritage Hotel.
<b>Oct 02</b>	Free day in Cape Town to enjoy an excursion up Table Mountain, stroll around the waterfront, visit the Greenmarket Square arts center and more. Cape Heritage Hotel.

# CAPE POINT & PENINSULA TOUR



Today you embark on a full day tour of the Cape Peninsula. Take in the beaches of Clifton and Camps Bay, before crossing over to Hout Bay. From here you drive to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve via Chapman's Peak, one of the world's most breathtaking coastal drives, where you will board a funicular to get to the top of the Peninsula to witness the symbolic meeting of the Indian and Atlantic Oceans and enjoy spectacular views over False Bay.



Stop in a seaside hamlet for lunch (on your own account) and then continue on to Simonstown, and visit the African Penguin breeding colony at Boulders Beach. If time allows you may stop for a stroll at the world famous Kirstenbosch Gardens.



# WINE COUNTRY TOUR

*CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA – FULL DAY TOUR*



This delightful drive winds its way into the heart of the Cape Winelands, through superb mountain ranges, vineyards and Cape Dutch homesteads. We begin in Stellenbosch with its great beauty and culture that is steeped in South African history. Walk down the canal-lined avenues in the shade of giant oak trees and beautifully-preserved buildings. With the sheer vastness of wine estates, your guide will cater the day to your preferences.

Travel over Helshoogte Pass to the town of Franshoek, historically dating back to the 17<sup>th</sup> century when the French Huguenots arrived. Billed as the Gourmet Capital of South Africa, we enjoy a wine tasting before taking time to enjoy the fabled culinary skills of the Franschoek chefs at one of the many award-winning restaurants (lunch not included).

Onward to Paarl, one of the Cape's first farming districts which is set at the foot of a cluster of granite domes. One more winery along the Paarl wine route before returning to the city by approximately 17:30.
