# ITINERARY

<b>Sep 28</b>	Morning transfer from Kogatende Airstrip to Zanzibar Island  Depart Kogatende at 9:45 a.m. and arrival in Zanzibar at 13:45 with a connection in Arusha. Met on arrival and transferred to Matemwe Beach Resort. Accommodation at Matemwe Lodge.
<b>Sep 29</b>	Full day in Zanzibar. Accommodation at Matemwe Lodge. Opportunity to visit Stone Town for a full day on any day of your choosing. One visit with transfers is included.
<b>Sep 30</b>	Full day in Zanzibar. Accommodation at Matemwe Lodge.
<b>Oct 1</b>	Full day in Zanzibar. Accommodation at Matemwe Lodge.
<b>Oct 2</b>	Transfer flight from Zanzibar to Dar es Salaam. There are several flights per day, which can be arranged based on your international return flight.
